Principal's Report

Focus on Academic Success of all students

Each and every tour we conduct for prospective parents or teachers in our school has a strong focus on the academic and personal success of each and every child. If you were to walk through any of our 47 classrooms in the morning, you will see consistent literacy teaching and learning taking place with a strong focus on our CAFÉ' reading program, VOICES Writing, strong spelling lessons and quality speaking and listening opportunities. 15 hours of the 25 hour timetable of learning is dedicated to literacy and numeracy, providing each and every student with the opportunity for success. This also represents 60% of the week dedicated to developing fundamental skills in our students. This is something that we have a relentless drive for in our school and something that we continue to be proud of. Keep up the focus for the remaining four weeks of the school year everyone.

Laurimar Primary School Maths Decathlon

Last Monday (13/11/2017), 24 Year 6 students were nominated by their classes to compete in the annual Maths Decathlon. Each class had their best four mathematicians competing in the ten events. The students completed engineering, number and space problems during the gruelling two-hour event.

All students demonstrated fantastic teamwork skills and persistence as they moved through each challenge. Grades 6A and 6B took the lead early and were both high finishes, but it was Mrs Greenwood's 6E who ultimately triumphed and won the race with a score of 49 points. The victors will be presented with the Laurimar Maths Decathlon Plaque at next week's assembly and they will proudly display the award in their room until next year's competition.

Alicia is not only our school captain, but she volunteers for a number of additional activities here at Laurimar Primary School.
